

**School Superintendent and Assistant Superintendent**

The superintendent is accountable to the board for all aspects of administering the school system under the policies adopted by the board. The superintendent is the primary educational leader of the school district.

The superintendent may delegate portions of administrative tasks to appropriate administrators. The responsibility for all activities within any building during school hours belongs to the designated head of that unit, who is accountable to the superintendent.
