

Bus Driver Examination and Training

All applicants being considered for employment who will be driving a district or a contract vehicle shall be carefully screened and their driving records scrutinized for violations through the Maine Bureau of Motor Vehicles (BMV), before recommendation for employment. Any violation on the applicant's BMV record may be a reason for disqualification.

The driving records of both district and contract regular drivers and spares will be reviewed by the Operations Director, or their designee, annually by July 1, before continuation of their employment. The annual license checks will be made through the Maine Bureau of Motor Vehicles. Any violation on the applicant's BMV record may be a reason for disqualification.

All drivers will complete a driver's physical prior to employment and annually thereafter. The physicals will be conducted per Maine Department of Education rule 081.6. The cost of the physical shall be borne by the driver's employer.

A copy of the physical will be maintained in the operations office.
