

FREE AND REDUCED PRICE FOOD PROGRAMS

The district shall take part as feasible in the National School Lunch and other food programs which may become available to assure that all children in the district receive proper nourishment. In accordance with guidelines for participation in these programs, and in accordance with the wishes of the board, no child who is improperly nourished, shall be denied a free lunch or other food simply because a proper application has not been received from his/her parent/guardian.

Hot or cold school meals will be provided in all schools. Cooks and their helpers will be responsible to the Food Services Supervisor.

The board will approve prices set for meals.

Students shall also be allowed to bring lunches from home and to purchase milk.

No student will be allowed to charge school meals after five (5) days. Adults are not allowed to charge for meals.
