

VENDING MACHINES

There shall be no vending machines in the schools of the district, with the exception of the teachers' lounges and those which dispense milk, water, paper, pens, pencils, notebooks and sanitary supplies. The district may write a contract with the provider of the vending machines, keeping the interest of the district in mind. Providers are required to pay a minimum of \$100 to defray associated costs. The district may adjust the rate as needed.

Coin operated soda or food machines may be placed in district schools at the discretion of the principal. Soda can only be sold in machines located in areas that are not accessible by students. Machines must be supervised by the district administrator or a designated faculty member. The district will be reimbursed for all electrical costs incurred by such machines. All profits must be used for student educational activities as arranged through the principal.
