

PROVISION OF SUPPORTIVE SERVICES TO EXCEPTIONAL STUDENTS

M.S.A.D. #49 recognizes that supportive services may be necessary to enable the exceptional student to benefit from special education services. Supportive services shall be an integral part of the educational objective(s) and shall be determined by the Individual Education Plan to be necessary in order for the student to benefit from public education.

M.S.A.D. #49 believes families bear primary responsibilities for those services which are of a medical nature, including therapeutic counseling.
