

ADULT EDUCATION PHILOSOPHY

The board of M.S.A.D. #49 believes that learning is a lifelong process. It is the policy of M.S.A.D. #49 to provide and encourage educational opportunities promoting career, citizenship and college readiness for all adults.

In encouraging the adults in the community, the board will provide active leadership and promote and advocate educational opportunities for adult students.

Eligibility

The following persons may attend adult education courses offered by M.S.A.D. #49 adult education:

- A person who is not yet 17 years of age who has withdrawn from school
- A person who is 17 years of age or older who is not attending public school
- A secondary school student enrolled in public day school program, if approved by the superintendent and adult education director

High school graduation requirements through adult education will be consistent with state law.
