9. Superintendent's Report

Dr. Baker reminded the board that the district staff is still working on developing assessments to meet the proficiency standards in language arts. The work will be on-going through the remainder of this year.

Superintendent Baker distributed copies of the collective bargaining agreement for the employees association and the teacher's association.

Dr. Baker noted that the Mid Maine Vocational Center awards were going on simultaneously with the board meeting in the Williamson Center. He also relayed that the Jobs for Maine Grads program is servicing 41 Lawrence students, with 6 freshman, 9 sophomores, 9 juniors and 17 seniors.

Assistant Principal David Packard reported that Benton hosted their “Bikes for Books” celebration. The Masons purchase two bikes for each grade level so a male and female student at each grade level win a bike, helmet and t-shirt. This year students read over 800 books. On May 21 Benton fifth grade teachers held their annual book publishing celebration in the library. Fifth grade students write and publish their own picture book.


