

Student Transportation Services

The Board of Directors accepts the responsibility of providing safe and efficient transportation to and from school for eligible students. The school district will provide transportation on established routes from designated stops on each route. Students may be required to walk reasonable distances to a designated stop. The district will also provide transportation in support of curricular and co-curricular programs as approved by the superintendent.

It is the intent of the Board to consolidate bus stops wherever possible, safe, and practical, and that the students be picked up and dropped off at designated stops. Parents/guardians are responsible for student travel to and from these designated stops and for providing appropriate supervision.

The Board of Directors recognizes that many students attend childcare centers before and after school hours and the District will attempt to accommodate requests for picking up and dropping students off at childcare within the constraints of district transportation services.
